

**OFFICIAL ADOPTION BY VOTERS; APPEALS**

Following the public hearing on the budget, and in accordance with state guidelines and regulations, the Holmdel Township Board of Education shall fix and determine, by a recorded roll-call majority vote of its full membership, the amount of money to be voted upon by the legal voters of the district in the annual budget election.

The school budget appropriations are officially acted upon by the voters at the annual school election. The voters may approve the appropriations as presented on the ballot or reject any item.

If a majority of the voters reject any item, the Board shall deliver the proposed school budget to the Township Committee within two days thereafter. The council shall, after consultation with the Board, and by the date fixed by law, determine the amount which, in its judgment, is necessary to be appropriated for each item appearing in the budget to provide a thorough and efficient system of schools in the district. The council shall certify the amounts required to the Monmouth County Board of Taxation.
