

GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE -- TITLE IX

It is the policy of the Holmdel Township Board of Education that pupils, employees, and parents/guardians may seek a remedy for an alleged violation relating to discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, sex, ancestry, disability, national origin, or social or economic status, through the use of the following grievance procedure and forms prescribed by the Director of the Office of Civil Rights, Washington, D.C.
