PATTERNS OF PARTICIPATION

The Holmdel Township Board of Education wishes to have input from all parties interested in planning and construction of new facilities and major alterations. Therefore, the superintendent shall develop procedures for encouraging parents/guardians, staff, students and community members to participate in all four stages of school construction:

- A. Identifying school building needs;
- B. Planning the school plant;
- C. Constructing the building(s); and,
- D. Accepting and using the plant.

Consultants shall exercise no administrative authority over the work of employees of the Board, but shall act only as advisors in those fields in which they are qualified.
